Faulty analogy examples

This small commercial tells Raymond's history. Raymond, it seems, he denied ice cream despite desperately to wish and have no reason to continue denying himself this treat. He claimed that now Raymond continues only to avoid ice cream because he simply got used to saying no. After drawing the absurdity of the choice of Raymond, the screen fades for black where we see the words "I spent all your life waiting. We saw the front of a car from Mercedes Benz, before the final words of the announcement: "Mercedes Benz. You're ready. I think the analogy arguments are often complicated for students to obtain an understanding, despite the fact that they probably use them daily. It becomes more and more complicated, then, when trying to show the speaking of false analogies and where students should draw the line. I always start this segment, establishing an easy and direct analogy, which makes sense to students, such as: "P1) The marker is a dry black expo marker with a chisel tip. I just removed it from Box earlier today. You can write on the whiteboard (I usually demonstrate for effect). (P2) Bookmark is also a black Expo erase marker with a chisel tip. I removed it from the box earlier today. (c) Therefore, it is probably that the marker B also can write on the whiteboard. Then we discuss if we are justified in doing the inductive jump in this analogy. Once the students saw as a good analogy It works, however, I show this announcement. It is short and should be shown in its entirety. I tell students to try to track analogy in the announcement. Using Vahoo as our reference point, they present them to class and discuss them together. In the course of this discussion, I point to students that the advertising of this type is really quite effective. After all, companies would not continue to allocate money so unless they were to work.
